Eston moves to Waverly

After months of anticipation, 28 February 2018 saw the official opening of the new premises for Coastals Eston at the old Waverley Store site. Invited members and guests joined the Coastals team to celebrate this momentous occasion.

Coastals first moved into the area in mid-2002, initially with a transformation period from the old Eston Co-op, run by the Dukes family, to the branch eventually becoming a self-standing, fully fledged Coastals branch. As with any new born, the branch grew over the years, and it became evident that the premises at Eston House were no longer adequate to sustain the growth, with larger, more modern premises being required.

The old Waverley Store site was identified as the ideal location, with it being on the main R624 between Eston and Richmond. The necessary legalities were concluded, and thereafter the task of transforming the historical buildings into a modern Coastals branch was handed to Trading Manager Russell Govender. This was no easy fix, as the building had to retain the front facade, as per AMAFA, due to it being a historical landmark. The end result is a magical mix of history and future, something that Russell and his team of contractors have achieved with aplomb.

The branch boasts a spacious, modern showroom, along with large storage facilities, all under one roof. The entire property is securely fenced to ensure the safety and security of members, customers and staff alike.

The future certainly looks bright for branch manager Una Wood and her team!
